Designed for high wear resistance and formability, Valast 500 is around four times harder than S355MC. This enables the use of thinner material for lightweight applications while delivering excellent abrasion and wear resistance. Typical applications include tipper truck bodies, asphalt finishers, mining equipment, screening machinery, and forestry equipment.

Valast 500 is available in coil form that can be cut to specific lengths to match your exact requirements. This flexibility reduces waste throughout the supply chain compared to reverse mill plate.

Additionally, cut-to-length sheets offer superior surface quality and

improved thickness control over traditional plate, potentially eliminating the need for further processing steps such as shot blasting.

Valast 500 ensures consistent properties and thickness for reliable, 24/7 trouble-free processing. It is designed for thermal cutting methods, including laser and (micro) plasma cutting, and it also demonstrates good weldability.

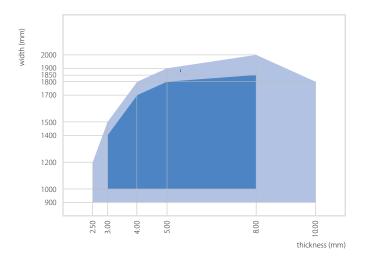
